Since December 1949 the Institute has borne the name of writer Volodymyr Galaktionovych Korolenko

1999

On December 9, 1999, the Ukrainian Cabinet of Ministers re-established the Institute as Poltava State Pedagogical University, and in 2009, the university received national status



PNPU has successfully gone through a government accreditation process and today consists of **8 faculties** and **36 departments**. We train students at the **bachelor, specialist, and master's level** according to a double-specialization program

Grynova Maryna Viktorivna

Since 2021, the University has been headed by Rector Grynova Maryna Viktorivna. Maryna Grynova is known in Ukraine as a teacher-innovator, a successful manager, a scientist of the new generation, and the initiator of the introduction of a modern pedagogical and educational strategy for the development of the personality of the future teacher of Natural Science disciplines, the author of about 800 works, including monographs, and educational and methodological manuals. She created her own potent scientific school: "Self-regulation as the basis of successful pedagogical activity". Under her leadership, scientists defended 17 doctoral and 71 Ph.D. theses

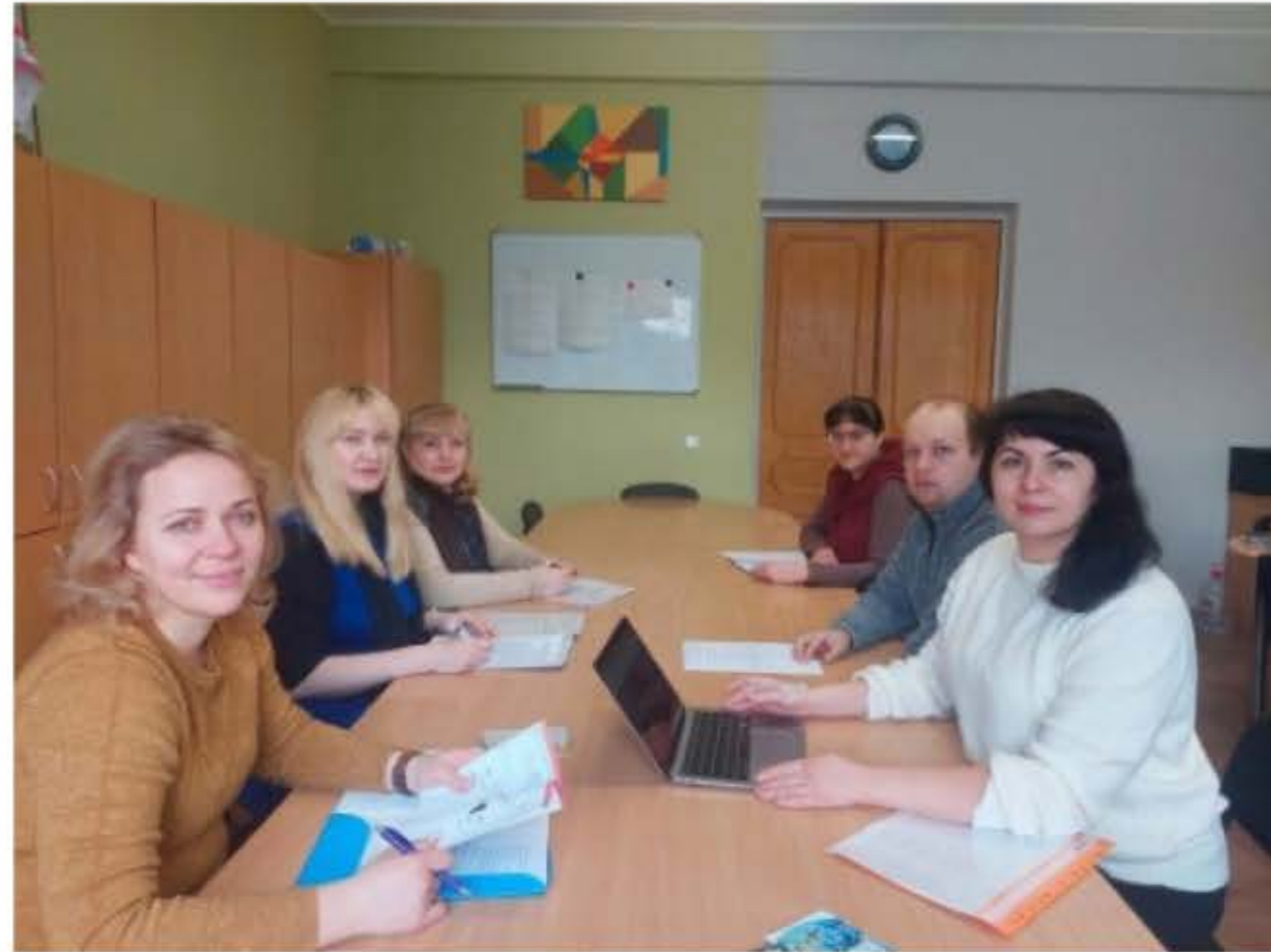

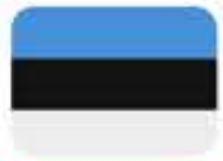
