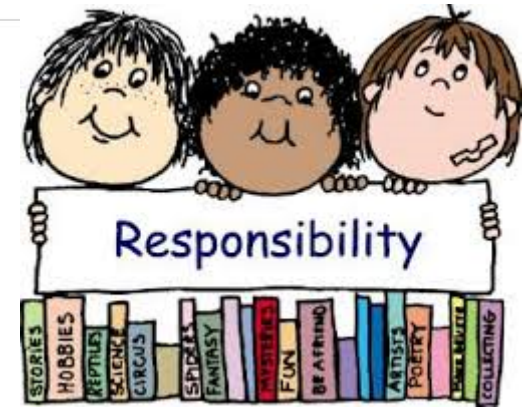
## New environment

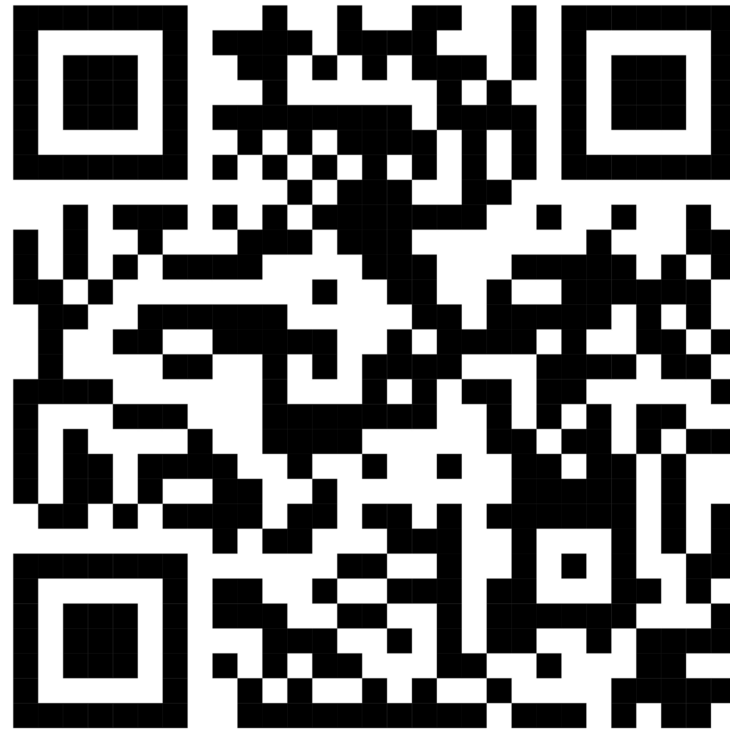
