




- Study programme: Social Entrepreneurship Education




# Organizing this BIP



- Finding partners in 2019/2020 (minimum of 3 institutes)
- Based on interest in the topic
- Doing an application for Erasmus+ call 2021
- During the preparations looking for additional partners
- IIA's are needed

# Organizing this BIP



## Funding the BIP as an organizing partner (Erasmus+)

- 400 euro per participant
- Funding minimum 15 participants! Maximum 20 funded participants (own participants don't count for the funding), no maximum for unfunded participants
- Be sure all incoming participants are registered in the Beneficiary Module (BM)
- Funding to be used like OS-money, for example organizing guest lectures, room rental, field trips etc.

# Organizing this BIP



## Funding for partners with outgoing participants (Erasmus+)

- Funding participating students/staff from budget Call KA131
- Registering participants in BM
- The activity type 'Student mobility for studies'. Then you tick the box 'Blended intensive programme'
- Connect to the right BIP
- Funding is per day; 5-30 days (79/56 euro, from Call 2023)
- Be aware of Green Travel and Top Up possibilities

- A working BM


## Tops
